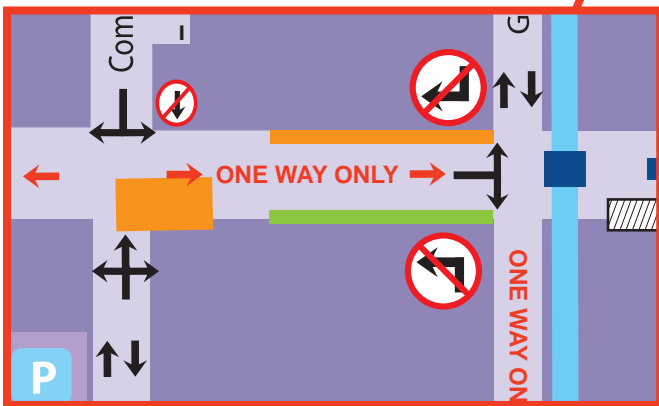
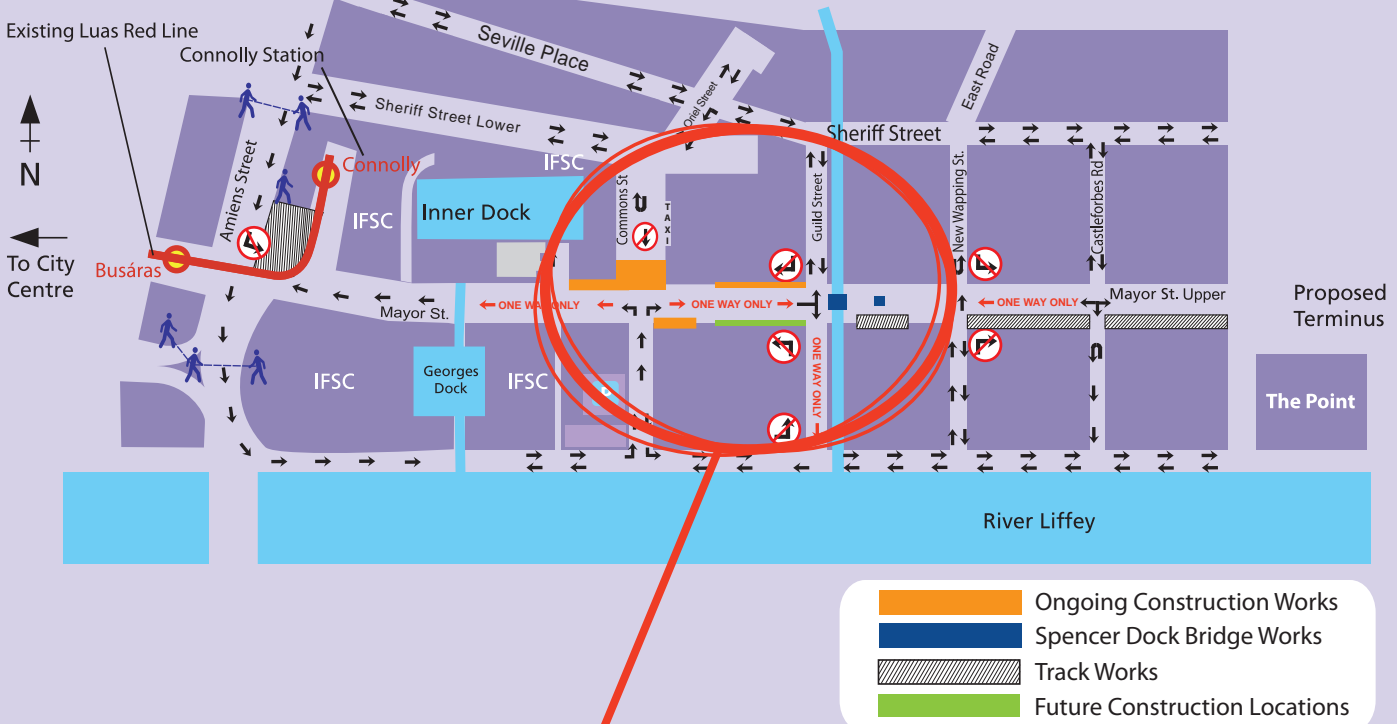


Mayor Street Traffic Diversions and Construction Works

UTILITY DIVERSIONS

Isolated excavations between Amiens Street and Guild Street

We are nearing completion of the switch overs and some excavations will remain open or will be re-opened over the coming weeks. These excavations are for switching of the last outstanding ESB and telecoms connections. Service providers will contact any affected customers in advance of switchover works. All water connections and switchovers as part of the Utilities Diversions Contract have now been completed.

Commons Street Junction

The crews have been working extremely hard on the utilities diversions in Commons Street junction. The works in excavation on the northside of the junction (near the Free Spirit Beauty Salon) will

be completed by mid-August 2008. At that moment, the last phase of the diversions into Commons Street Junction will begin and we aim to complete this work by early September. The map shows the excavation on the south side of the junction (at the corner with Bank Of Ireland). All Northbound traffic coming from North Wall Quay onto Commons Street will be unrestricted and will be able to go right towards Guild Street, turn left towards Amiens Street or go straight through to Sherrif Street Lower or Seville Place via Oriel Street. For the duration of this phase of works only there will be no southbound traffic through the Commons Street junction from Mayor Street Lower to the Quays. We ask all road users to obey the traffic wardens and temporary traffic signs.
